It is good to honor the dead.

It is unhealthy to seek to communicate with them and foolish to address prayers to them. It is just as foolish and unhealthy to address prayers to the dead of others under the pretense that they are saints. The issue is not about keeping the skulls, but considering them as things to pray to or as intermediaries between us and God.

Anyone who complains about having no luck is certainly a pagan. The word luck does not exist anywhere in the Bible. I refuse to have good luck wished upon me because that concept has no place in my life. Therefore, if someone returns from church and complains about having no luck, tell them that they themselves do not understand why they go to church, they do not believe in God, and it is therefore normal for them to have such results. For us who believe in the Lord, we rely on His grace and not on luck, and we know that all things work together for good to those who love God and are called according to His purpose. Thus, we cannot proclaim our faith in God and at the same time talk about luck or misfortune in our lives.

This cult of the dead he speaks of, in 5800 years without Christianity, has just succeeded in producing slavery, colonization, and a predominantly occult and evil science for black people. Today, it would suddenly be the essential source of a luck that we cannot do
