3. His own statement, John 3:5: *“Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.”*

The Bible itself is full of evidence of His existence (just read His own words in the Bible, including the Lord's Prayer).

4. His daily manifestations in the lives of thousands of people. Specialists in denial who wish to dismiss the lived experiences of these thousands should explain these experiences. Simple research on YouTube or TikTok gives numerous testimonies. We ourselves have many testimonies. If someone who does not exist produces so many results, one should indeed be concerned.
5. Testimonies from Satanists who cannot tolerate His name also confirm His existence. It is sheer dishonesty to claim that He never existed.
6. Ask Google Gemini (gemini.google.com): *“On what basis do people claim that at that time there was no city called Nazareth in Galilee? Cite all your sources.”*
7. The simplest way is to experiment with His existence, as we are speaking of a living being, who still reveals Himself, not of someone dead.
8. Ask an AI: *“Can the existence of Jesus be denied on historical grounds? Why do some do so? Cite all your sources.”* Read the answer.
9. Another solid and detailed argumentation is provided below:

What do you think about Jesus Christ? Is He real or just a myth?

Of course, Jesus is real and exactly what the Bible says He was. There is a major piece of evidence often overlooked: the very existence of Christianity.

Historical evidence of Christianity exists before 60 AD, and in fact, evidence indicates that the first three Gospels were written before this date.

For example, these Gospels contain predictions of Jesus about the destruction of Jerusalem, but they do not mention the fulfilment of this prophecy, which occurred in 70 AD.

Matthew 24:1-2: *“And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and His disciples came to Him for to shew Him the buildings of the temple. And Jesus*

said unto them, See ye not all these things? Verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.”

Mark 13:1-2: “And as He went out of the temple, one of His disciples saith unto Him, Master, see what manner of stones and what buildings are here! And Jesus answering said unto him, Seest thou these great buildings? there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.”

Luke 21:5-6: “And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, He said, The days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.”

If someone wrote a work of fiction or history about Jesus after 70 AD, mentioning that this prophecy had been fulfilled would have given it greater credibility. Therefore, these three Gospels must have been written before 70 AD. Furthermore, the Book of Acts ends with the Apostle Paul still alive, so it must have been written before his execution, generally dated after 67 AD.

The important point here is that evidence indicates that three of the Gospels as well as the Book of Acts were written before 70 AD. The earliest possible date for the crucifixion is around 30 AD. This means that three of the four Gospels, the Book of Acts, and all the Epistles of Paul were written within 40 years of the crucifixion.

If one were inventing a great miraculous religious figure, would they place him in a time and place where people could still verify the facts? There were still living witnesses in Jerusalem at that time who remembered what happened around 30 AD. If someone had invented such a figure, they would place him in a distant past where no one could contest him.

The fact is that Christians were persecuted for their faith in Jesus only a few decades after the reported events. This includes the Apostles themselves, who, if they had invented everything—or even merely exaggerated a real person—would have abandoned their religion once their lives were in danger. They endured because they deeply believed what they preached.

In summary, we have clear evidence that the Gospels are ancient, that Christianity emerged shortly after the period when Jesus is said to have been crucified and resurrected. Realistically, this only makes sense if these events were based on a real person named Yeshua (Jesus in Latin), who performed miracles, was crucified, and truly resurrected. The very existence of

Christianity is proof of the reality of the life, death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

II. Refutations of Some Arguments Against the Existence of Jesus Christ

1. Many who take these paths attack the person rather than focusing on the debate question itself, which is clumsy, rude, and reflects the spirit they carry.
2. They reject all historical sources that contradict their position or claim them to be falsified, without proving that their own sources are authentic.

They claim Flavius Josephus' mention of Jesus Christ is a forgery, yet ignore other mentions of Jesus by Josephus, particularly regarding James, the brother of Jesus Christ.

This apparent dishonesty can be further examined by simply asking an AI (ChatGPT or another): *"Can the existence of Jesus be denied on historical grounds? Why do some do so? Cite all your sources."* You can consult the response here:

The fact that some people have denied Jesus Christ's existence is not proof that He did not exist, especially as they are not contemporaries and would only accept the testimonies of contemporary writers. Yet they cite non-contemporaries to prove His non-existence! Even if they were contemporaries, in a time without phones, internet, or social media, it is unlikely they knew about Him.

3. *"No writer of Jesus' time wrote about Him, which proves He did not exist."*

This is flawed reasoning. Since when is the condition for someone's existence that a writer must have mentioned them? Josephus mentions James, the

brother of Jesus Christ. Paul spoke of Jesus in multiple Epistles, as did other Apostles. Luke wrote after careful investigation from eyewitnesses.

Why should a Roman writer necessarily write about Jesus Christ? And even a Jew? When the chief priests organised a lie about Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:11-15), the truth had to be transmitted by Christians, who were whipped or killed for speaking about Him. Which non-Christian writer would have dared?

4. *“The Gospels disagree on Jesus’ birth date, proving He did not exist.”*

Ridiculous. If two people give differing testimonies about you, does that prove you never existed? No. The Gospels are testimonies given long after the events. Even in Africa, for people born before 1900, exact birth dates are often unknown; “born around” is used.

5. The story of the pigs being false as proof Jesus did not exist is ignorant. Even if false, does it disprove your existence? The location was populated by Gentiles, making the story plausible.
6. Jesus’ refuge in Egypt does not disprove Him. Arguments about the Exodus are irrelevant; a false claim about someone does not negate their existence.
7. Multiple authors deny Jesus’ existence. This proves nothing. People denying Jesus exist since apostolic times (Paul and John discuss it in the Bible). Their numbers do not validate their claims.
8. *“We cannot use the Bible to prove Jesus’ existence because it is not credible.”*

In law, the burden of proof is on the accuser. Those who attack the Bible often seek evidence within it to attack it, but refuse to let it defend itself.

9. Similarities with other mythic figures (Osiris, Mithra) do not disprove Jesus Christ. Those figures are mythic; Jesus is a historical figure. Jesus taught, was baptised, died voluntarily for salvation, and resurrected. None of these mythic figures did.
10. Jesus Christ is alive and active. Unlike mythic figures, He has a presence and teaching. Those who deny Him should explain His

deliverance of many from Satan's power. Christianity is a personal relationship with Christ; He is alive and manifests today.
